Program Goals

We provide a well-organized program where your child can have fun in a safe learning environment. Our goal is to extend your child's learning in the critical skill areas important to his/her academic success. We provide highly qualified teachers who will be pro-active in assisting your child's learning. While our after-school program is not designed to be a Mandarin immersion program, we do provide many native Mandarin speaking teachers for your child to interact throughout the afternoon. We hope you will take advantage of the many enrichment learning opportunities we offer, as we believe it is important to educate the whole child!

Chinese Class: (Traditional Characters, Taiwan textbooks)

1. Each student will receive a notebook, folder, textbook, and workbook.
2. Each student receives a monthly curriculum outline and objectives for the month.
3. A progress report will be provided monthly.
4. Every Friday will be focused on culture, calligraphy, public speaking, recitations.
5. Options are provided for simplified writing assigned as homework only.
6. Homework will be assigned M-Th.

Homework and Tutorials

1. Each student receives help with homework given by their own school.
2. If the child has no homework, or can complete it in adequate time, each child receives math review and English writing practice.
3. Each child receives a notebook, folder, and worksheet packets for math and English writing practice.
4. Singapore Math books may be purchased separately.
5. A progress report will be provided monthly.

Enrichment Classes

- Private music lessons are scheduled individually and worked around the student's other activities.
- All music students receive a PILA music record book.
- All music students receive a quarterly progress report.
- All music and dance students participate in two recitals per year.
- All Kung Fu students participate in two performances per year.
- Painting students participate in an art show two times per year.
- Art class includes all materials. There is a one-time \$5 fee for art show each semester.
- All students participate with our own PILA day school students' Christmas and Spring Performance.

Additional Information

- All students are expected to wear PILA T-shirt when attending full days. Other days are optional.
- All students bring their own snacks.

- 4 days: \$425/mo (no calligraphy)
- Includes Chinese class, calligraphy, books/materials
- Includes Homework help, tutorials in math and English, all materials

Kindergarten; 11:30-6:30 pm

(Mandarin Immersion program:(2+hrs Mandarin daily, art/music/PE wkly)

- Five Days: \$595.00/mo
- Four Days: \$525.00/mo

Language Classes Only (includes materials)

- Mandarin: M-Fri 1 hr/dy: \$550/2 mos.
- Spanish: 3 days:TBA: Heritage, Beginner
- French: 2 day: TBA, Heritage Speaker

Additional Enrollment Fees

- All Day: 8:30-3:30; \$60/dy
- Early Release: up to 2 hours; \$15/day
- Early Release: 2-4 hours; \$35/day

Enrollment Fees: Due at time of enrollment

- \$40 non-refundable application fee per child. Due with application.
- 1st month tuition
- Deposit: one month tuition credited toward last month attendance.
- Sibling discount of 10% off the lowest tuition

Withdraw Notice

- A written notice 30 days in advance to withdraw a child is required, or deposit will not be refund.
- A written notice 30 days in advance to drop an enrichment activity is required, or full payment is required.
- A written notice 30 days in advance to change program schedule/days of attendance is required or full payment is required.
- **There is no credit or refund for sick days/personal vacation days/absences of any kind.**

Tuition Information: Payment must be made through your bank's autopay system.

- Payment due by 1st of each month.
- Late fee is \$25/per child if payment is received after the 3rd.
- PILA may terminate the service if the payment is not made by the 10th day of the month.
- \$35 will be charged for a returned check.

No other vacation tuition credit/refund is given to any full/part time students at PILA ASELP during the school year.

Late Pick Up Fee There is a charge of \$15/per 15 min increments for late pickup. Cash or check payment should be made promptly at the late pickup time and made directly to the staff member waiting with your child.

Termination: PILA CDC reserves the right to terminate a child's enrollment if it is determined that the program no longer meets the needs of the child, if the parents fail to comply with the payment & admission agreement/program policies/pick up policies & Student/Parent Handbook, and/or if the child's behavior is determined to be at risk to himself/herself and/or others.

Enrichment Classes (additional fees apply)

- Private piano; \$35/30 min. + \$10 recital fee/sem
- Private Suzuki violin: \$40/30 min. + \$10 recital fee/sem
- Private Guitar: \$25/30 min. + \$10 recital fee/sem
- Cooking/Sewing/Jewelry: \$10/mo.
- Painting/Art: \$75/mo. + \$5/art show/sem.
- Kung Fu: \$75/mo. Does not include uniform + \$10 performance fee/sem
- Dance:\$75/mo.does not include dance outfit + \$10 recital fee/sem
- Private tutorials: Any language class, 1:1 \$50/hour; 3:1\$20/hour
